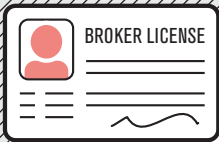


Take a prep course and then the exam

April 30th

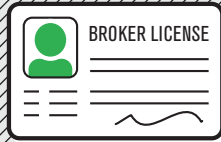


Complete 18 hours of continuing education

April 30th

Option 2



Complete 30-hour course and pass a final exam
★ There are no retakes on the proficiency exam,
but there are retakes on the 30-hour final exam.



Apply for broker license with IDFPR on or before
April 30th

★ Taking the 30-hour transition course
fulfills continuing education requirements
for this renewal cycle.



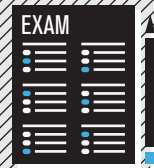

Option 1

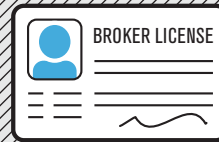


Take a prep course and then the exam

April 30th



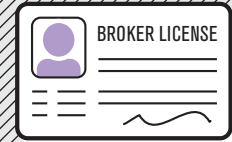
Complete 18 hours of continuing education

Complete 12-hour Broker Management course
on or before April 30th

Option 2



Complete 45-hour course and pass a final exam
★ There are no retakes on the proficiency exam,
but there are retakes on the 45-hour final exam.



Apply for managing broker license with IDFPR on
or before April 30th



Complete an additional 18 hours (three Core A,
6 Core B and 9 Elective) continuing education
credit on or before April 30th



No broker management course is required

★ 12-hour broker management course is waived
when completing the 45-hour transition course.
